Darfuris in North America

Press Release on current events in Darfur

Currently, our people in the Internally Displaced Persons (IDP) camp of Kalma are under threat of violence, homelessness, and lack of basic life subsistence. The threat is coming from the local government of South Darfur and from central government in Khartoum. Similar conditions are faced by IDPs in Hamideyeh in the Zalengi area of West Darfur.

The Government of Sudan is intent on dismantling these camps by force. The Government officials in South Darfur made their intentions very clear in defiance of all international protocols and conventions that protect IDPs. This is a continuation of the crimes of genocide in Darfur.

We would like to point to the fact that the Government of Sudan is carrying out this scheme of dismantling the IDP camps openly by:

- 1- Flooding the camps with weapons and at the same time pitting the refugees against each other causing violence to erupt.
- 2- The current Governor of South Darfur, AbdelHamid Kasha, is well known among the Darfuris as one of the officials who participated in the campaigns of ethnic cleansing in Darfur in the years 2003, 2004, 2005, and 2006. Kasha has stated blatantly in few days ago that he is going to dismantle Kalma camp and disperse its people. Kasha is the same official who threatened to expel UNAMID from South Darfur, a threat that was backed by Khartoum publicly.
- 3- The humanitarian organizations (NGOs) are barred from entering many IDP camps by the Government of Sudan. There are many complaints that food, medicine and water are running short in many camps in South and West Darfur. The Government of Sudan inhumanely uses the basic humanitarian aid, coupled with violence, as a tool to force the IDPs out of these camps.
- 4- The international community is astonishingly MIA (missing-in-action). UNAMID is threatened with expulsion, NGOs are barred from entering the IDP camps, and humanitarian aid flights have been almost totally grounded.

We believe strongly that the Government of Sudan, sadly, has perfected reading in advance the reaction of the international community, and the United States in particular.

The Government of Sudan, headed by a President indicted for genocide, war crimes and crimes against humanity, continues using same tactics used by other genocidal perpetrators through history to finish the job. They will not stop till they are stopped.

The Government of Sudan feels absolutely immune to any accountability. Furthermore, the officials in Khartoum and South Darfur audaciously state their plans in dismantling the IDP camps in meetings with UNAMID and NGOs representatives.

We believe that what is happening in Darfur has direct relation to the U. S. policy in handling Darfur's crisis.

The international community has an obligation to protect the Darfuri civilians. This Responsibility-To-Protect (R2P) should be exercised now to stop the on-going genocide in Darfur.
